

What You Need to Know about Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An overdraft occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. At Gate City Bank, we refer to these as Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) Transactions. We offer the ability to pay for these NSF transactions and cover them in three different ways:

1. We have standard NSF practices that come with your account.
2. We also offer a Checking Reserve Line of Credit, Classic Overdraft Line of Credit, and a Savings Link service, which may be less expensive than our standard NSF practices. To learn more, simply give us a call at 800-423-3344 or contact us at <https://www.gatecity.bank/>.

This notice explains our standard NSF practices.

What are the standard NSF practices that come with my account?

We do authorize and pay NSF's for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay NSF's for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay NSF's at our discretion, which means we do not guarantee that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do not authorize and pay an NSF, your transaction will be declined or returned.

What fees will I be charged if Gate City Bank pays my NSF transaction?

Under our standard NSF practices:

- We will charge you a fee of **\$32** each time we pay an NSF
- Also, if your account is overdrawn for 5 or more consecutive days, we will charge an additional \$8 per day, beginning on the 5th day
- There is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for NSF transactions on your account
